SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT

DAFI Tertiary Education Scholarships (Dadaab, Kakuma and Urban)

Windle Charitable Trust in partnership with UNHCR invites applications for suitably qualified refugee candidates resident in Kenya for the DAFI 2017 Education Scholarships

This scholarship programme is funded by the German government, administered by UNHCR and implemented by Windle Trust Kenya (WTK) and with the goal of helping refugee students to access post-secondary education. The scholarship covers all tuition and fees associated with the academic course of the scholars.

1. **Scholarship Academic Level of Study:** Diploma and Degree

2. **Requirements and Qualification:** Every Applicant MUST:

- a) Be a holder of valid refugee status (Having GoK Refugee ID card and UNHCR protection document)
- b) Be 28 years of age and below at the time of application
- c) Have original academic documents from a recognized academic institution
- d) Demonstrate financial need for education and strong contribution to community
- e) Not be benefiting from any other scholarship at the time of application
- f) Not on an immediate resettlement process.

Minimum KCSE (or equivalent) Academic Requirement for **DEGREE course** is C+ for female applicants and B- for male applicants and **DIPLOMA course** is C for female applicants and C+ for male applicants.

3. **Targeted Fields of Study** include Business Administration/ Commerce, Communication and Journalism, Education, Environment, Health, Information Technology, Law, Nutrition, Social/ Community Work and Water Engineering.

4. **How to Apply:**

- a) Application forms are available at Windle Trust Offices in Nairobi. They are also available at the Reception Desk of UNHCR Branch Office in Nairobi. They can also be downloaded from www.windle.org. **The forms are free of charge.**
- b) Applicant shall indicate up to **three** academic programs in order of preference.
- c) Applicant shall attach copies of academic documents (certificates and transcripts where applicable) from a recognized academic institution, GoK Refugee ID or waiting card and UNHCR protection document.

5. **Application Deadline:**

Applicant shall submit application in person to Windle Trust Kenya office in Dadaab, Kakuma camps and Nairobi or at the Reception Desk of UNHCR Branch Office in Nairobi **on or before Friday, May 19th 2017 at 4.00 pm.**

6. **Important Notes:**

- a) Qualified Female candidates, Persons with Special Needs, those admitted to a public university/college and those seeking partial assistance are encouraged to apply.
- b) Names of short-listed candidates shall be posted at Windle Trust offices in Dadaab, Kakuma camps and Nairobi and at UNHCR field offices in Dadaab, Kakuma camps and Branch office in Nairobi. **Only short-listed candidates shall be invited for the interviews.**
