SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT

DD PURI Foundation Scholarships-4 Positions in Dadaab

Windle Trust Kenya in partnership with the DD Puri Foundation, invites applications for suitably qualified Refugee candidates in Kenya for the DD Puri Foundation SCORE Project 2017 Scholarships described below. This scholarship programme is funded by the DD Puri Foundation and administered by Windle Trust Kenya with the goal of helping refugee students to access post-secondary education. The scholarship covers all tuition and fees associated with the academic course of the scholars.

- Scholarship Targeted Academic Courses:** Diploma courses in *Water Engineering* at Kenya Water Institute, *Community Health Nursing* at Kenya Medical Training College and *Information Technology* or *Business Information Technology* at Jomo Kenyatta University of Agriculture and Technology. This scholarship will support at least one position for each of the listed study areas.
- Qualification:** Every Applicant MUST:
 - Be holder of valid refugee status (GOK refugee certificate and UNHCR protection document)
 - Have original academic documents from a recognized academic institution.
 - Demonstrate financial need for education
 - Demonstrate strong contribution to community
 - Never have received any other scholarship
 - Be 30 years old and below at the time of application
 - Not be on an immediate resettlement process

Minimum KCSE Academic Requirements: Mean grade **C Plain** or equivalent. Aspiring applicants for Diploma in Community Health Nursing **MUST** have scored minimum C Plain in English/Kiswahili and Biology or Biological sciences and C-(minus) in chemistry or Physics/Physical Science and Mathematics. For other courses, applicants with C in English, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry or Physical Sciences, Biology or Biological Sciences may have an added advantage.

3. **How to Apply:**

- Application forms are available at Windle Trust Office in Dadaab Camps or at the Principal's office in any of the WTK secondary schools in Dadaab camps. They can also be downloaded from www.windle.org. The forms are free of charge.
- Applicant shall indicate up to **three** academic programs in order of preference.
- Applicant must attach copies of academic documents (certificates & transcripts where applicable) from recognized academic institutions where they have studied, GoK refugee ID or waiting card, UNHCR proof of registration and UNHCR ration card.

4. **Application Deadline:**

Applicants shall submit application in person to Windle Trust Kenya Office or at the principal's office in any WTK secondary schools in Dadaab Camps **on or before Friday, May 19th at 4pm.**

5. **Important Notes**

- Qualified Female candidates and Persons with Special Needs are encouraged to apply.
- Applicants who demonstrate strong contribution to community will have added advantage.
- Names of short-listed candidates shall be posted at WTK offices and UNHCR field offices in Dadaab. **Only short-listed candidates shall be invited for the interview.**
