

SPONSORSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT

WUSC SRP 2019 sponsorships

World University Service of Canada (WUSC) in partnership with Windle International Kenya (WIK), a member of Windle Trust International Federation invites suitable refugees from Kenya for the selection of 2019 WUSC Student Refugee Program (SRP) candidates. The SRP is a resettlement program that enables refugee students to enter Canada as Permanent Residents and pursue their education at Canadian universities, Collège d'enseignement général et professionnel (CEGEPs) and colleges.

1. Qualification

I. General

All Applicants must:

- Have **original UNHCR Proof of Registration** and **Government of Kenya Refugee Identification Card**.
- Have original **Primary and Secondary schools Leaving certificates and result slips, and any other academic documents**.
- Have **continuously** lived in the refugee camp for more than **2 years**.
- Be between the ages of **17 to 25 years old** at the date of submitting their applications.
- Be **SINGLE** (not married) and without dependents.
- Be proficient in English or French.

2. How to Apply

- a) Application forms are available from Windle International Kenya (WIK) office in Kakuma Refugee Camp, Principal's offices in Dadaab camps, and the main office in Nairobi.
- b) It is strongly advised that ALL **camp-based** refugee students collect application forms from Windle International Kenya (WIK) office in Kakuma and Principal's offices in Dadaab camps. Urban refugees to pick their application forms from WIK Nairobi office. The forms are free of charge.
The completed forms should be returned to the location where application forms were collected from before Friday 16th March 2018 at 4.00 pm.
- c) **Candidates must attach clear copies of Refugee Identification Card or waiting card, UNHCR proof of registration, Primary and Secondary academic School Certificates, School Leaving Certificate and other academic documents** to the application form.

3. Application Deadline

Friday 16th March 2018 at 4.00 pm. No application will be accepted after the deadline.

4. Important Notes

- a) WUSC SRP allows candidates to apply up to three times in the subsequent years after which any further applications will not be accepted.
- b) All candidates who meet minimum requirements will be invited for the pre-interview TOEFL written test as part of the short listing for an interview.
- c) Names of short-listed candidates who meet the pre-TOEFL written test will be posted in WIK offices 14 working days after the closure of receiving applications.
- d) Only short-listed candidates who pass the pre-TOEFL written test will be invited for the final oral interviews selection process. Any oral interviews linkages amongst the candidates will lead to cancellation of oral interviews in the entire centre.
- e) Qualified Female candidates and Persons with Special Needs are encouraged to apply.
- f) Candidates who demonstrate strong contribution to community will have added advantage but that on itself is not a qualification guarantee.
