



SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT

DAFI Tertiary Education Scholarships in Dadaab, Kakuma and Urban

Windle International Kenya in partnership with UNHCR invites applications for suitably qualified refugee candidates resident in Kenya for the DAFI 2019 Tertiary Education Scholarships

This scholarship programme is funded by the Federal Republic of Germany, administered by UNHCR and implemented by Windle International Kenya (WIK) and with the goal of helping refugee students to access post-secondary education. The scholarship covers all tuition and fees associated with the academic course of the scholars.

1. **Scholarship Academic Level of Study:** Diploma and Degree.

2. **Qualification:** Every Applicant MUST:

- Be a holder of valid refugee status (Having GoK Refugee ID card and UNHCR protection document)
- Be 28 years of age and below at the time of application
- Have original academic documents from a recognized academic institution
- Demonstrate financial need for education and strong contribution to community
- Not be benefiting from any other scholarship at the time of application
- Not on an immediate resettlement process.

Minimum KCSE (or equivalent) Academic Requirement for **DEGREE course** is C+ for female applicants and B- for male applicants and **DIPLOMA course** is C for female applicants and C+ for male applicants.

3. **Academic Courses:** Priority shall be given to academic courses which take a maximum duration of **FOUR** academic years.

4. **Admission** to a public university/ college is an added advantage but NOT a guarantee for selection.

5. **How to Apply:**

- Application forms are available at Windle International office in Nairobi, Kakuma and Dadaab. They are also available at the Reception Desk of UNHCR Branch Office in Nairobi. They can also be downloaded from www.windle.org. **The forms are free of charge.**
- Applicant shall indicate up to **three** academic programs in order of preference.
- Applicant shall attach copies of academic documents (certificates and transcripts where applicable) from a recognized academic institution, GoK Refugee ID or waiting card, GoK/UNHCR proof of registration and UNHCR protection document.

6. **Application Deadline:**

Applicant shall submit the completed application in person to Windle International Kenya office in Nairobi **on or before Friday, June 7th 2019 at 4.00 pm.**

7. **Important Notes:**

- Candidates possessing **non-Kenya academic documents** are advised to translate and equate them where applicable.
- Eligible female candidates, Persons with Special Needs and those seeking partial education assistance are encouraged to apply.
- Names of short-listed candidates shall be posted at Windle International Kenya office in Nairobi, Kakuma and Dadaab. **Only short-listed candidates shall be invited for the interviews.**
