SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT

DD PURI Foundation SCORE Project Scholarships- Dadaab

Windle International Kenya (WIK) in partnership with the DD Puri Foundation invites applications for suitably qualified refugee candidates resident in Kenya for the DD Puri Foundation SCORE Project 2019 Scholarships described below. This scholarship programme is funded by the DD Puri Foundation and administered by Windle International Kenya with the goal of helping refugee students to access post-secondary education. The scholarship covers all tuition and fees associated with the academic course of the scholars.

1. **Scholarship Targeted Academic Courses:** Diploma courses in *Water Engineering* at Kenya Water Institute, *Community Health Nursing* at Kenya Medical Training College and *Information Technology or Business Information Technology* at Jomo Kenyatta University of Agriculture and Technology. This scholarship will support at least one position for each of the listed study areas.

NB/ One qualified Female student will be awarded scholarship for Certificate level training in Community Health Nursing.

2. **Requirements and Qualification:** Every Applicant MUST:

- a) Be holder of valid refugee status (GOK refugee ID/Waiting Card and UNHCR protection document).
- b) Be 30 years of age and below at the time of application.
- c) Have original academic documents from a recognized academic institution.
- d) Demonstrate financial need for education and strong contribution to community
- e) Not benefiting from any other scholarship at the time of application
- f) Not on an immediate resettlement process

Minimum KCSE Academic Requirements: Mean grade **C Plain** or equivalent. Aspiring applicants for Diploma in Community Health Nursing **MUST** have scored minimum C Plain in English/Kiswahili and Biology or Biological sciences and C-(minus) in chemistry or Physics/Physical Science and Mathematics. For other courses, applicants with C in English, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry or Physical Sciences, Biology or Biological Sciences may have an added advantage.

Academic requirements for Certificate level training in Community Health Nursing (female applicants only): KCSE mean grade **C-(Minus)** with minimum C-(Minus) in English/Kiswahili and Biology or Biological sciences, D+ (Plus) in Chemistry, Physics or Physical sciences or mathematics

3. **How to Apply:**

- a) Application forms are available at Windle International Kenya Offices in which are in all secondary schools in Dadaab camps. They can also be downloaded from www.windle.org. **The forms are free of charge.**
- b) Applicant shall indicate up to **three** academic programs in order of preference.
- c) Applicant must attach copies of academic documents (certificates and transcripts where applicable) from a recognized academic institution, GoK refugee ID or waiting card, GoK/UNHCR proof of registration and UNHCR ration card.

4. **Application Deadline:**

Applicants shall submit the completed application in person to respective Windle International Kenya Secondary schools in Dadaab Camp **on or before Friday, June 7th at 4pm.**

5. **Important Notes**

- a) Eligible female candidates and Persons with Special Needs are encouraged to apply.
- b) Applicants who demonstrate strong contribution to community will have added advantage.
- c) Names of short-listed candidates shall be posted at respective WIK offices in Dadaab. **Only short-listed candidates shall be invited for the interviews.**
