GRANT OPPORTUNITY ANNOUNCEMENT  
School Board of Management (BOM)  
Kenya Equity in Education Project-II (KEEP-II)**

Windle International Kenya (WIK), a member of Windle International in partnership with World University Service of Canada (WUSC) invites applications from Board of Management of KEEP-II supported schools for the award of small grants towards the support of School Improvement Planning. This grant is funded by UKAID and is made up to the sum of KES 100,000 per successful BOM application with costs covering areas of the BOM School improvement planning that best contribute towards the realization of a positive supportive environment that values and promotes girls' education.

**1. Qualification:**

Every Applying School Board of Management MUST:

- a. Have taken part in previous KEEP –II organized BOM training
- b. Submit an application on the stipulated application form *(provided by KEEP-II)*
- c. Be from the KEEP-II targeted schools *(List of schools available on [http://windle.org/document\\_library.html/](http://windle.org/document_library.html/) and at WIK offices in Dadaab and Kakuma)*
- d. Proposals must demonstrate an appreciation of shifting gender and social inclusion dynamics in light of Covid-19. *(Preference will be given to proposals that innovatively support girls continued learning at home and when schools reopen, address SGBV and its impacts on continued education for learners and safeguarding and Child protection)*

**2 How to Apply**

Application forms are available **free of charge** at WIK Offices in Dadaab and Kakuma and on [http://windle.org/document\\_library.html/](http://windle.org/document_library.html/) Application forms must be filled-in and submitted together with budget in the stipulated templates either physically at the WIK office in Dadaab/Kakuma or through the email [grants@windle.org](mailto:grants@windle.org) with the email subject clearly stating KEEP-II BOM GRANT APPLICATION. *(A School can only submit one application in response to this call)*

**3. Application Deadline**

School BOM are required to submit their application by 2:00pm, Monday, 21st September 2020.

**4. Important Notes**

- a) Names of successful grant applications will be available at the WIK Dadaab and Kakuma Office, Dadaab and Kakuma Sub County Education offices and at the UNHCR Field Offices.
- b) Sending in an application is not a guarantee that you will receive a grant. Grants will be awarded competitively to 10 schools in Kakuma region and 15 schools in Dadaab region in this call.
- d) Successful applicants will receive grants through Bank Transfers. It is therefore mandatory that the schools have Bank Accounts for proper Accountability.**
- e) Those who applied at the beginning of the year in February-March period MUST apply again if they wish to be considered for the grant award. Ensure adherence to the new qualification criteria.**
