





GRANT OPPORTUNITY ANNOUNCEMENT

School Board of Management (BOM) Kenya Equity in Education Project-II (KEEP-II)

Windle International Kenya (WIK), a member of Windle International in partnership with World University Service of Canada (WUSC) invites applications from Board of Management of KEEP-II supported schools for the third round of the award of small grants towards the support of School Improvement Planning. This grant is funded by UKAID and is made up to the sum of KES 100,000 per successful BOM application with costs covering areas of the BOM School improvement planning that best contribute towards the realization of a positive supportive environment that values and promotes girls' education in schools.

Every Applying School Board of Management MUST:

- a. Submit an application on the stipulated application form (provided by KEEP-II).
- b. Be from the KEEP-II targeted schools and NOT have received any award in previous cycles of the KEEP-II BOM grant calls.
- c. Demonstrate Gender and Social inclusion in its proposal. (Grant evaluation criteria shall award highest marks to proposals that clearly identify and address the needs of most vulnerable subgroups in schools such as girls living with disability, orphans, survivors of sexual and gender-based violence, teenage mothers, ethnic minorities, extreme poverty households etc).
- d. Attach minutes signed by the BOM members demonstrating their participation in formulating the proposed intervention.

2 How to Apply

Application forms and Evaluation criteria are available free of charge at WIK Offices in Dadaab and Kakuma and on http://windle.org/document library.html. Application forms must be filled-in and submitted together with budget in the stipulated templates either physically at the WIK office in Dadaab/Kakuma or through the email grants@windle.org with the email subject clearly stating THIRD TRANCHE KEEP-II BOM GRANT APPLICATION. (A School can only submit one application in response to this call).

3. Application Deadline

School BOM are required to submit their application by 18th November 2021 at 4pm EAT

4. Important Note

Grants shall be awarded competitively to 8 schools in Kakuma region (4 In the Host Community based schools and 4 in the Refugee Camp based schools) and 12 schools in Dadaab region (6 in the Host Community based schools and 6 in the Refugee Camp based schools) in this call.
