



## SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT TECHNICAL AND VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING

Windle International Kenya (WIK) is a humanitarian education organization providing education to refugees and needy Kenyans. WIK was founded in 1977 with the belief that good education was essential if Africa was to meet the challenges it faced. We are working with communities in Dadaab, Fafi, Wajir South, Turkana West, Dadaab Refugee Camp, Kakuma Refugee Camp and Kalobeyi Settlement on education projects.

Refugees in Schools Everywhere in partnership with Windle International Kenya invites applications from suitably qualified female candidates from the host community and refugees in Dadaab, Kakuma and Kalobeyi for the Vocational Training Scholarship. The scholarship shall cover tuition and fees associated with the academic course of the scholars.

### 1. QUALIFICATIONS

Eligible applicants MUST:

- i. Be female living in settlement refugee camps in Dadaab, Kakuma and Kalobeyi and the surrounding host communities
- ii. Hold a minimum mean grade in the Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education (KCSE) of C-
- iii. Have up to date registration documents
  - For host community – have a national identity card (ID)
  - For refugees - be a holder of valid refugee status (Having GoK Refugee ID card and UNHCR protection document) and not be in the immediate resettlement process
- iv. Have original academic documents from a recognized academic institution
- v. Demonstrate financial need for education and strong contribution to community
- vi. Not be benefiting from any other scholarship at the time of application

### 2. HOW TO APPLY

No other form of application will be accepted.
- ii. **Kindly note the forms are free of charge** – WIK does not charge or require you to pay any money for the application process.
- iii. The applicant shall indicate up to **two** academic programs in order of preference.
- iv. The applicant shall upload a passport size photo, copies of academic documents (certificates and transcripts where applicable) from a recognized academic institution, GoK Refugee ID or waiting card, GoK/UNHCR proof of registration and UNHCR ration card, copies of National ID for the host community


### 3. APPLICATION DEADLINE

Applicants should submit the completed application online **on or before Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> July 2021.**

### 4. IMPORTANT NOTES

Names of short-listed candidates shall be posted at the respective WIK offices in Dadaab, Kakuma and Kalobeyi.  
**Only short-listed candidates shall be invited for interviews.**
